The Paradise Center for the Arts Healing Arts Gallery at District One Hospital is a collaboration between the Paradise Center for the Arts and District One Hospital. The program features artist in a variety of two-dimensional mediums and styles that promote healing and well-being. We encourage all levels of artists to submit their work for consideration.

- Exhibits are 6 months long.
- Next call for artists is for the 2021 winter/2022 spring exhibition, exhibition dates are mid-December 2021 – mid-June 2022. **Call for Artist deadline for 2021 winter/2022 spring exhibition:** November 12, 2021.
- Galleries (areas) can feature anywhere from 3 to 19 pieces, depending on the size of the piece(s).
- There is no commission given to District One Hospital or the Paradise Center for the Arts if the artwork is sold, 100% of the sale goes to the artist.
- The artwork must be 8X10 inches or larger and be ready to hang (with a wire).

To submit your artwork for consideration, email the following information to info@paradisecenterforthearts.org

1. Low resolution image(s) in jpeg format of the completed piece(s) you would like the committee to consider. Please name your files with last name and title.
2. Image list including artist name, title, medium, price and size (height, width, and depth) of each piece. Image list will need to be a text file, MSWord, or PDF.

3. Artist statement and/or artist's resume in a text file, MSWord, or PDF, please include phone number, mailing address, and email.
4. All artworks must be framed and must have a **wire for hanging**, no saw tooth hangers or hooks. We use the Walker Hanging System at District One Hospital.

Every precaution will be taken in handling your artwork, but no responsibility is assumed by the Paradise Center for the Arts or District One Hospital for loss or damage of any kind. Submission of work indicates acceptance of these conditions.
