



## **Call for Art – MN Musician(s) inspired Artwork**

Paradise Center for the Arts is seeking submissions of artwork from visual artists, that is inspired by MN Musicians for a pop-up exhibition opening March 25, 2022. All artworks must be inspired by MN Musicians, or MN Musician's music/lyrics.

Submissions will be accepted any time before **February 27, 2022** and artists will be notified no later than **March 5, 2022**. Exhibition dates March 25-May 7, 2022.

- **Image(s)** of the artwork in JPEG format not to exceed 10 MB. File names for image file(s) should be in the form of last name, first initial, and image title. Abbreviate as needed. CD will not be returned.
- Short **artist statement about the artwork submitted, image list** (Please list the sizes, medium, year made, & price of your work). Text files must be in one of the following formats: MSWord, RTF (Rich text format), PDF, or Text Only.

### **Timeline**

- February 27 submission deadline
- March 5 notification to artists
- March 17 & March 18 12pm-5pm, March 19 10am-2pm drop off artwork at the Paradise
- March 25 MN Musicians pop-up exhibition gallery opening with live music 5pm-7pm
- Pick up artwork May 9 9am-12pm, May 12 & May 13 12pm-5pm

### **Requirements**

- Artwork must be dry
- 2D Artwork must be ready to hang. 3D Artwork must be ready for installation.
- Artwork that has been created in the last 2 years. Each artist can submit up to 4 pieces.
- Artists are responsible for drop off, pick up, and insuring their artwork
- Artwork cannot be any larger than 4 feet in any direction
- Put a label on the back of your artwork that includes your name, phone number, email, title, medium, price
- Artwork must be for Sale. Paradise takes a 35% commission. Paradise will need a W9 when your artwork sells

Every precaution will be taken in handling your artwork, but no responsibility is assumed by the Paradise Center for the Arts for loss or damage of any kind. Submission of work indicates acceptance of these conditions.
